ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-6

AN ORDINANCE providing for and requiring the submission of the proposition of issuing \$900,000 Library Bonds to the voters of the Smithton Public Library District, St. Clair County, Illinois, at the general primary election to be held on the 20th day of March, 2012.

WHEREAS, The Board of Library Trustees (the "Board") of the Smithton Public Library District, St. Clair County, Illinois (the "District"), has found and determined and does hereby find and determine that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District, in order to operate an efficient public library system, to repair, remodel, improve and build an addition to the existing library building, construct site improvements, furnish necessary equipment and acquire library materials and electronic data storage and retrieval facilities in connection therewith (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Board has heretofore determined and does hereby determine that it is in the best interests of the District that the cost of the Project be borrowed against the credit of the District and that bonds of the District be issued for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, before said bonds can be issued, a proposition therefore (the "*Proposition*") must be submitted to the voters of the District and be approved by a majority of the voters of the District voting upon said proposition; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the District that the proposition be submitted to the voters of the District at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election law of the State of Illinois:

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by The Board of Library Trustees of the Smithton Public Library District, St. Clair County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.
- Section 2. Need for Project. It is necessary and in the best interests of the District, in order to operate an efficient public library system, that funds be made available for the payment of costs of the Project.
- Section 3. Estimated Cost. It is hereby found and determined that the estimated cost of the Project is \$900,000, and that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District that the sum of \$900,000 be borrowed and in evidence thereof bonds of the District be issued.
- Section 4. Term of Bonds. It is hereby found and determined to be for the best interests of the District that said bonds proposed to be issued be payable over a period of time not to exceed twenty (20) years from the date of issuance thereof.
- Section 5. The Proposition. The Proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the District in accordance with the general election law of the State of Illinois at the general primary election to be held on Tuesday, the 20th day of March, 2012, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M. on said day (the "Election").
- Section 6. Voting Precincts and Polling Places. The Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board (the "County Board") of The County of St. Clair, Illinois (the "County"), for voters of the District at the Election.
- Section 7. Election Notice. The County Clerk of the County (the "County Clerk") shall give notice of the Election (the "Notice") in accordance with the general election law of the State of Illinois by (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District, and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the County Clerk.

Section 8. Local Notice. The Secretary of the Board shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the District.

Section 9. Published Notice. It is hereby found and determined that ______ is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District, as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").

Section 10. Form of Notice. The Notice shall appear over the name or title of the County Clerk and shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general primary election to be held on Tuesday, the 20th day of March, 2012, the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the Smithton Public Library District, St. Clair County, Illinois:

Shall the bonds of the Smithton Public Library District, St. Clair County, Illinois, in the amount of \$900,000 be issued for the purpose of repairing, remodeling, improving and building an addition to the existing library building, constructing site improvements, furnishing necessary equipment and acquiring library materials and electronic data storage and retrieval facilities in connection therewith?

Section 14. Canvass of Election. The Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law of the State of Illinois.

Section 15. Repealer. All ordinances, orders and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 16. Posting of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be posted in a public area of each of the library buildings of the District within 3 days after the date of enactment and shall remain posted for 14 days.
