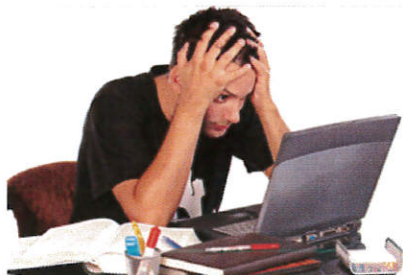




Monthly Classes
