
AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY AND ASSESS A TAX
FOR SMITHTON PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT OF THE
COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2020 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Smithton Public Library District of the County of St. Clair and State of Illinois shall levy a tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said District, for building and maintenance purposes, subject to the right of the electors in said District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that within fifteen (15) days from the date of adoption of the ordinance, it shall be published in the Freeburg Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the Smithton Public Library District and it is effective immediately upon adoption.





BE IT ORDAINED, that the Smithton Public Library District of the County of St. Clair and State of Illinois shall levy a tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said District, for building and maintenance purposes, subject to the right of the electors in said District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that within fifteen (15) days from the date of adoption of the ordinance, it shall be published in the Freeburg Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the Smithton Public Library District and it is effective immediately upon adoption.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunder set our hands in Smithton, Illinois this 20th day of August, 2020.

1. The specific number of voters required to sign a petition requesting that the question of adoption of the ordinance be submitted to the electors of the District is 404.
2. The petition must be filed on or before September 21, 2020.
3. The referendum would be held April 6, 2021.
