APPLICATION & SELECTION

- The Smithton Public Library District Board of Trustees recently created a new opportunity for teens to volunteer with the library. Teens can now apply to be a teen liaison between the Smithton Public Library District Board of Trustees, the Smithton Public Library District staff and the Smithton community
- Teen Liaisons will be responsible for leading teen library programming, such as facilitating a teen advisory board, a book club or other fun events
- Teen Liaisons are appointed by the Smithton Public Library District Board of Trustees
- The Smithton Public Library District Board of Trustees may select 1 or more Teen Liaisons per application cycle
- An applicant **must** live in the Smithton Public Library District
- An applicant **must** be between the ages of 16 and 18 years old
- An applicant should possess an interest in working with the Smithton Public Library District Board of Trustees, Library Staff, and the Smithton community
- An applicant will help keep the Smithton Public Library District relevant to the Library District's younger patrons and to the Smithton community
- An applicant should represent good character
